A Research Reserve for Connecticut

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) designated the nation's 30th National Estuarine Research Reserve on January 14, 2022. This action established about 50,000 acres of eastern Long Island Sound, western Fishers Island Sound, lower Connecticut River, lower Thames River, and select adjacent marshes, and upland areas as the Connecticut National Estuarine Research Reserve (CT NERR).
